Can you believe that it is already time for to re-enroll for the 2020-2021 school year? In preparation for next school year, please take the time now to complete the re-enrollment packet.

To complete the online enrollment process, you will need to access your Parents Web through your existing login. If you do not have a login, please follow the *Instructions for Creating a Parents Web Login* listed below.

To access Parents Web

- Please go to www.renweb.com
- Select Logins from the menu bar and **Parents Web Login** from the drop-down menu.
- Type in your username and password. If you have forgotten your username and password, please click on the forgot username or password link.
- After logging in, click on apply/enroll and then enrollment/reenrollment, click the blue link that says click here to open enrollment

Our Online Enrollment System will open with a link to the enrollment packet for (Student First Name). The process should take about 15 minutes to complete. Your information will be saved if you need to quit and come back at a later time to complete.

The Instructions and Enrollment Checklist page of the packet contains supplemental forms that also need to be completed and submitted. Further instructions on these forms can be found online.

All returning Bethesda Academy students <u>must</u> complete a FACTS Tuition Management Financial Aid form each year in order to be considered for receiving financial aid assistance from Bethesda Academy. After financial aid has been awarded and parents have agreed to the tuition amount, the parents must then complete their payment plan within the FACTS system. The application and the FACTS processes are both separate actions within the same company and **BOTH** must be completed prior to setting an appointment with the Admissions Director to officially sign your son's Bethesda Enrollment Contract.
